

Selection Policy

Last updated November 2023

The Jersey Squash and Racketball Association (“JSRA”) is responsible for the development of squash in Jersey and for selection of teams and individual players for representative competition.

This policy sets out the procedure to be followed by the JSRA Committee when selecting players to represent Jersey and individuals to compete in JSRA approved events.

Selection Panels

1. Senior Selection - This panel will consist of a minimum of 2 officers selected from the JSRA Committee with the President of the JSRA holding a casting vote, if necessary. The JSRA Committee is elected at its AGM each May and the selectors will be appointed at the first subsequent Committee meeting and their names published on the JSRA web site. The current selectors are Anthony Harkin and Susan Turpin
2. Junior Selection – This panel will consist of the Head of the Jersey Squash Academy together with a minimum of two officers selected from the JSRA Committee. The President of the JSRA will hold a casting vote as necessary.

Applications

The JSRA will publish the list of events to which this selection policy applies on the JSRA website as soon as they are known. Certain competitions such as Commonwealth Games, European Team Championships, Island Games, Inter Insular etc have differing requirements regarding residential qualification. Residency and other selection criteria unique to each event will, where possible, be circulated to JSRA members.

Any player wishing to be considered for selection must notify the selectors of their availability by the deadline that will be published with each event. It is in every player’s own interest to keep up-to-date with forthcoming events as failure to do so could jeopardise their chance of selection.

Selection of all players is at the discretion of the selection panels and will be based principally on availability, match results as posted to Sporty HQ, (where a player’s results on Sporty HQ are inconclusive, the selection panel may organise play-offs to determine the team(s) playing order), commitment, adherence to the codes of conduct, attendance at training and other published selection criteria. Players may also be required to attend official or social functions.
